PROJECT

The Hilbert School District underwent a \$4.6 million project encompassing a 9,500 sq. ft. addition and 8,300 sq. ft. remodel of the Hilbert Middle/High School in 2010. The expansion project included a new science wing, along with the remodel of the library and computer lab. As existing exterior signage was to remain, SignElements® was referred to provide an interior sign package for the new schools.
