## PROJECT

After years of planning and debate, the Village of Mount Pleasant completed an initiative to combine and relocate the village hall and police department to a new 90-acre civic campus in the spring of 2011.

Incorporating a variety of custom materials and sign types, this interior and exterior architectural package encompassed ADA and life-safety signage, lobby logo, dedication plaque, dimensional letters and monument sign. Throughout the designing of this exclusive project, a solution was developed to avoid mounting signs on glass, the new magnetic bracket mounting system offered by SignElements®.
